

Changes Are Coming!



WRYC has been hosting an average of over 800 campers and 250 volunteers each summer. Every year, camp is packed full, and it is obvious when eating in the dining hall, sitting in the church building for chapel, singing at the amphitheater, or crowded into the Opry House. We squeeze into every available space. It is because of this and gracious donations, we currently have two large projects underway.

MOSES OPRY HOUSE HOTEL - The first is the remodel and repurposing of the Opry House as the "Moses Opry House Hotel" which will be heated and air conditioned. Not only will this add an additional four private rooms and private baths with a remodel of the original rooms, but plans are in the works to

add a laundry room and small kitchen.

NEW MULTI-PURPOSE BUILDING - The construction of a heated and air conditioned 4,800 square foot Multi-Purpose building will begin after the first of the year. The building will seat 350 people, be used for assemblies and activities during camp, be available for retreats, lectureships, banquets, and weddings. It will include restrooms for large groups and eventually a commercial kitchen. It will also have large "garage doors" that will open to an outdoor garden area.

Thank you to our donors and to all who have volunteered their time and energy to the construction of the newest additions to WRYC.

Summer is right around the corner. We have 164 days until we move back out to camp and begin to get WRYC ready for YOU! Are you ready for us? We have our dates available. Plan now, invite your friends and/or youth group and get ready to join us for Summer '23. Look for our registration to open at the end of January.
